As PRME Chapter signatory institutions, we are pleased to offer a limited number of **PhD and DBA student and PostDoc scholarships to support scholars engaging in sustainability/responsible management (RM) research and/or education to participate actively in our upcoming international Chapter Conference**, taking place on **Thursday 21– Friday 22 May 2026 at ICN Business School, Nancy, France.**

This initiative is designed as a benefit to PRME signatory schools and will fully support selected PhD students' participation in the meeting, including accommodation, registration costs and refunding of "green"\* travel costs for a total value of 500€. Selected PhD, DBA students and postdoc researchers will join the PRME community as active participants throughout the meeting, engaging with educators, practitioners, researchers, journal editors, partner organisations and fellow students committed to advancing sustainability and RM initiatives and research.

We would greatly appreciate your support in sharing this opportunity with eligible individuals and encouraging applications from those whose initiatives, impact, and leadership reflect the spirit of PRME.

### **Application Requirements**

Eligible individuals are invited to submit a one-page motivation letter, addressed to the Chapter Steering Committee, reflecting on the following:

1. How does your submission clearly align with the PRME Mission and Principles?
2. How is your submission relevant to one of the conference streams?
3. How does your submission contribute to debates on RM, sustainability, ethics or social impact?
4. Why are you interested in receiving this PRME Chapter scholarship?

Students are encouraged to use specific examples to support their reflections.

Qualifying individuals must provide (i) proof of registration in a PhD or DBA programme or recipient of postdoc contract in a PRME signatory school; (ii) an updated CV in English; (iii) an impactful project, poster, paper in development or full paper they will present during the conference.
