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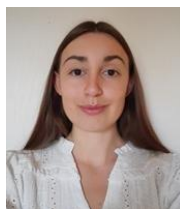

Admission procedure for Bachelor and Master exchange programmes

1. Partner universities must nominate selected students [ONLINE NOMINATION](#)
2. Students fill out [ONLINE APPLICATION FORM](#) with the required documents

Required documents

- ✓ Completed online application form
- ✓ ID photo
- ✓ Copy of passport or identity card
- ✓ Academic transcripts from the last 2 years
- ✓ Curriculum vitae in French or in English (depending on the language of study)
- ✓ Letter of motivation in French or in English (depending on the language of study)
- ✓ For non-native English speakers: Copy of TOEFL or IELTS or TOEIC or Certificate of Cambridge or Duolingo if program in English or a certificate showing they have successfully completed a degree program taught in English or are currently studying in English at their home institution.
- ✓ Attestation of French B2 level from home university if program in French

Language requirements for non-native speakers

B2 Level (CERF scale). [TOEFL](#): 80 or [IELTS](#): 6,5 or [TOEIC](#): 750 or Certificate of [Cambridge level C](#) or [Duolingo](#) 100 (please share results with "ICN Business School - Exchange Programs Only") or a certificate showing they have successfully completed a degree program taught in English or are currently studying in English at their home institution

Academic and grading system

ICN Business School uses the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS). A full academic year corresponds to 60 ECTS credits, reflecting the workload associated with defined learning outcomes.

Courses typically combine lectures, seminars, and case-based learning. Students can expect an average of 20 to 25 classroom hours per week. Each course is usually assessed through a mix of continuous assessment and final examination.

The teaching staff includes both academic professors and industry professionals, providing students with both theoretical and practical insights.

ICN applies the standard French grading scale, from 0 (lowest) to 20 (highest). The minimum passing grade is 10/20. Grades above 15 are rarely awarded, and a mark of 14 is considered very good.
